**ORDER**

On October 15, 2002, Bagley Acquisition Corporation, The Buhl Building, LLC, Fort-Washington Associates, LLC, and M.A.E. Development, LLC, (Bagley et al.) filed a complaint against The Detroit Edison Company.

On July 23, 2003, Bagley et al. requested permission to withdraw their complaint.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The request by Bagley et al. to withdraw the complaint should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request filed by Bagley Acquisition Corporation, The Buhl Building, LLC, Fort-Washington Associates, LLC, and M.A.E. Development, LLC, to withdraw their complaint against The Detroit Edison Company is granted.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
