ORDER

On December 19, 2002, the Detroit-Wayne Joint Building Authority filed a complaint against The Detroit Edison Company over its steam rates and terms of service. On October 17, 2003, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint and for the Commission to dismiss the case with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 300, as amended, MCL 462.2 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of the Detroit-Wayne Joint Building Authority against the Detroit Edison Company is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
