ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On April 16, 2004, Nordic Marketing, L.L.C. (Nordic), filed a formal complaint against The Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison) alleging that Detroit Edison violated the code of conduct and the Commission's slamming and cramming rules and/or orders by both authorized and unauthorized customer contact and slamming. Detroit Edison filed an answer denying all charges. On June 14, 2004, Nordic moved to have its complaint against Detroit Edison dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint filed by Nordic Marketing, L.L.C., against The Detroit Edison Company is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
