OPINION AND ORDER

On May 10, 2002, AEP Ohio Commercial & Industrial Retail Company, LLC (AEP Ohio), submitted an application, pursuant to the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, MCL 460.10 *et seq.*, for a license as an alternative electric supplier (AES). An AES is a person selling electric generation service to retail customers in this state, other than a person who physically delivers electricity directly to retail customers. MCL 460.10g(1)(a). In an order dated October 3, 2002, the Commission approved AEP Ohio's license as an AES in the State of Michigan.

On January 6, 2005, AEP Ohio requested the voluntary relinquishment of that license, and the Commission Staff recommends that the Commission approve this request.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 *et seq.*; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 *et seq.*; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. AEP Ohio's voluntary relinquishment of its license as an AES should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that AEP Ohio Commercial & Industrial Retail Company, LLC's license as an alternative electric supplier in the State of Michigan is hereby canceled.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
