ORDER

On September 15, 2004, Theresa Hypnarowicz filed a complaint against The Detroit Edison Company and Michigan Consolidated Gas Company regarding a billing dispute. On November 19, 2004 and December 17, 2004, the complainant filed amended complaints. On January 31, 2005, the parties filed a joint request to withdraw the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 *et seq.*; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 *et seq.*; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Theresa Hypnarowicz against The Detroit Edison Company and Michigan Consolidated Gas Company is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
