ORDER

On March 24, 2005, Michigan Paperboard Corp. and Factory Mutual Insurance Company, as subrogee of Michigan Paperboard Corp., filed a complaint against Consumers Energy Company regarding the failure of an electrical transformer.

On June 22, 2006, the complainants filed a request to withdraw the complaint.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 *et seq.*; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 *et seq.*; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. The complaint should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Michigan Paperboard Corp. and Factory Mutual Insurance Company, as subrogee of Michigan Paperboard Corp., against Consumers Energy Company is dismissed.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
