OPINION AND ORDER

On May 24, 2006, Great Lakes Energy Cooperative (Great Lakes) filed an application for authority to discontinue electric service to a residential customer due to a dispute over the utility’s access to the customer’s property for the purpose of conducting tree trimming and brush clearing activities.

On August 18, 2006, Great Lakes filed a request for dismissal of this matter without prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 *et seq.*; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 *et seq.*; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as

amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*

b. Great Lakes request for dismissal of this matter should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Great Lakes Energy Cooperative's August 18, 2006 request for dismissal of its May 24, 2006 complaint against a residential customer is granted without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12).
