**ORDER**

On March 29, 2007, Green Tree Composites, L.L.C., filed a complaint against Indiana & Michigan Power Company, d/b/a American Electric Power, alleging that the company failed to maintain its power lines and provide adequate service and capacity. On October 22, 2007, the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, MCL 460.551 *et seq.*; 1919 PA 419, MCL 460.51 *et seq.*; 1939 PA 3, MCL 460.1 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Green Tree Composites, L.L.C., against Indiana & Michigan Power Company, d/b/a American Electric Power, is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
