ORDER

On March 28, 2005, Suez Energy Resources NA, Inc., (Suez) submitted an application, pursuant to the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, 2000 PA 141, MCL 460.10 *et seq.*, for a license as an alternative electric supplier (AES), and in an order dated October 18, 2005 in Case No. U-14559, the Commission approved Suez's AES license in the State of Michigan.

On July 28, 2008, Suez requested the voluntary relinquishment of its AES license and also requested that the Commission release and return its \$100,000 letter of credit supplied in accordance with the requirements to be licensed as a retail electric supplier in Michigan. The Commission Staff recommends approval of this request, noting that although Suez obtained a license it never began operations and is not serving any customers in Michigan.

The Commission finds that Suez's voluntary relinquishment of its license as an AES and the release and return of Suez's \$100,000 letter of credit should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Suez Energy Resources NA, Inc.'s license as an alternative electric supplier in the State of Michigan is hereby rescinded and its request for the release and return of its \$100,000 letter of credit is granted.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
