**ORDER**

On February 3, 2004, Nordic Marketing of Michigan, LLC, (Nordic) submitted an application pursuant to the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, 2000 PA 141, MCL 460.10 *et seq.*, for a license as an alternative electric supplier (AES). In an order dated August 31, 2004 in Case No. U-14168, the Commission approved Nordic’s license in the State of Michigan.

On April 3, 2009, Nordic requested voluntary relinquishment of its AES license and to be relieved of its obligations to comply with the reporting requirements for AESs as well as the new requirements established by Public Acts 286 and 295 of 2008 and the Commission’s implementation orders. The Commission Staff recommends approval of this request because

Nordic has no retail customers in Michigan as of December 31, 2005, it relinquished its agreements with the Midwest ISO, and it dissolved its limited liability company in the State of Michigan on March 18, 2009.

The Commission finds that Nordic's voluntary relinquishment of its AES license should be approved.

Because the Commission approved Nordic's request to voluntarily relinquish its AES license, the Commission finds that Nordic shall be relieved of its obligations to comply with the reporting requirements for AESs as well as the new requirements established by Public Acts 286 and 295 of 2008 and the Commission's implementation orders. The Commission authorizes the Commission Secretary to close Case No. U-15839.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. Nordic Marketing of Michigan, LLC's, license as an alternative electric supplier in the State of Michigan is hereby rescinded.

B. Nordic Marketing of Michigan, LLC, is relieved of any obligation to comply with the reporting requirements for AESs and the new requirements established by Public Acts 286 and 295 of 2008 and the Commission's implementation orders.

C. The Commission Secretary is authorized to close Case No. U-15839.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
