**ORDER**

On March 16, 2006, American PowerNet Management, L.P. (American PowerNet), filed an application in accordance with the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, 2000 PA 141, MCL 460.10 *et seq.*, for a license as an alternative electric supplier (AES), and in an order dated May 25, 2006, the Commission approved American PowerNet's AES license in the state of Michigan.

On December 21, 2009, American PowerNet requested the voluntary relinquishment of its AES license and return of its \$100,000 letter of credit. The Commission Staff recommends approval of this request because American PowerNet currently has no retail electric customers in this state and has indicated that it has no intent to commence operation in the future. The Commission finds that the application is reasonable and in the public interest, and should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the alternative electric supplier license of American PowerNet Management, L.P., is rescinded and its request for the release and return of its \$100,000 letter of credit is granted.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
