II. Description of Filing

2. On September 17, 2007, American Electric Power Corporation (“AEP”) filed a Complaint and Motion to Consolidate against the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (“Midwest ISO”) and PJM Interconnection, LLC (“PJM”), alleging that the rate designs underlying the open access transmission tariffs are unjust, unreasonable, and unduly discriminatory and therefore must be revised. AEP proposes a replacement rate design that would share the costs of all existing and new “backbone” extra high voltage transmission facilities across the combined PJM/Midwest ISO Super Region. AEP requests that the Commission establish a refund-effective date of October 1, 2007 or an alternative date of February 1, 2008.

III. Notice of Intervention

3. The Michigan Public Service Commission is an agency of the State of Michigan, created by 1939 PA 3, MCL 460.1 *et seq.* As the Michigan regulatory agency having jurisdiction and authority to control and regulate rates, charges, and conditions of service for the retail sale of electricity in the state, the Michigan Public Service Commission intervenes in this matter pursuant to the authority conferred by applicable state statutes, rules, and procedures.
