**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

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II. Basis for Intervention

The MPSC is an agency of the State of Michigan, created by 1939 Pub. Acts 3, Mich. Comp. Laws Ann. § 460.1 *et seq.* As the Michigan regulatory agency having jurisdiction and authority to control and regulate, rates, charges, and conditions of service for the retail sale of electricity in the State, the MPSC intervenes in this matter pursuant to the authority conferred by applicable state statutes, rules, and procedures.

III. Description of Filing

On April 6, 2004, Commonwealth Edison Company, ("ComEd") and PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("PJM"), tendered for filing with the Commission an unexecuted Service Agreement under PJM's OATT to meet the conditions of prior Commission orders to hold harmless utilities in Michigan and Wisconsin from the financial impacts of loop flows and congestion resulting from the choice of ComEd to participate as a transmission-owning member of PJM.

IV. Conclusion

WHEREFORE, the MPSC hereby provides notice of its intervention.

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
