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**II.          Basis for Intervention**

The MPSC is an agency of the State of Michigan, created by 1939 Pub. Acts 3, Mich. Comp. Laws Ann. § 460.1 *et seq.* As the Michigan regulatory agency having jurisdiction and authority to control and regulate, rates, charges, and conditions of service for the retail sale of

electricity in the State, the MPSC intervenes in this matter pursuant to the authority conferred by applicable state statutes, rules, and procedures.

### **III. Description of Filing**

On March 31, 2005, American Electric Power Service Corporation (“AEPSC”), on behalf of Appalachian Power Company, Columbus Southern Power Company, Indiana Michigan Power Company, Kentucky Power Company, Kingsport Power Company, Ohio Power Company, and Wheeling Power Company, submitted for filing proposed electric transmission rates to be included in the Open Access Transmission Tariff of PJM. AEPSC requested an effective date of June 1, 2005.
