**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF THE
THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION**

Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2007), the September 19, 2007 Notice of Filing, and the October 5, 2007 Notice of Extension of Time issued by the Commission, the Michigan Public Service Commission (“MPSC”) hereby submits its notice of intervention. The MPSC states as follows.

I. DESCRIPTION OF THE FILING

On September 11, 2007, Direct Energy Services, LLC (“DES”) filed an appeal from the August 21, 2007 decision of the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”) to include DES on the NERC Compliance Registry as a load serving entity. Also on September 11, 2007, in Docket No. RC07-6-000, Sempra Energy Solutions LLC (“Sempra”) filed an appeal of NERC’s decision to affirm a determination by *ReliabilityFirst* Corporation that Sempra be included in the Compliance Registry for the function of a load-serving entity. And on the same day, in Docket No. RC07-7-000, Strategic Energy, L.L.C. (“Strategic Energy”) filed an appeal of NERC’s decision, which allegedly misplaced Strategic Energy in the compliance registry as a load serving entity.

II. NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

The MPSC is an agency of the State of Michigan, created by 1939 Pub. Acts 3, Mich. Comp. Laws Ann. § 460.1 *et seq.* As the Michigan regulatory agency having jurisdiction and authority to control and regulate rates, charges, and conditions of service for the retail sale of electricity in the State, the MPSC is a “state commission” as defined in 16 U.S.C. § 796(15) and 18 C.F.R. § 1.101(k) (2006). Accordingly, the MPSC hereby provides its notice of intervention pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.214(a) (2) (2006).

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The MPSC supports a finding by the Commission that would ensure that the NERC requirements that are applicable to LSEs are applied to the appellants in a manner necessary to ensure that all of NERC's reliability rules are implemented effectively. Furthermore, the MPSC also reserves the right to amend its pleading under Rule 215, 18 C.F.R. § 385.215 (2007).

III. CONCLUSION

As set forth more fully above, the MPSC hereby provides its notice of intervention in this proceeding.
