R 460.20606 of the Michigan Administrative Code is amended as follows:

PART 6. ADOPTION OF STANDARDS

R 460. 20606 Office of pipeline safety, research and special programs administration standards; adoption by reference.

Rule 906. (1) The following office of pipeline safety, research and special programs administration standard is adopted by reference in these rules THIS RULE and is available, FROM THE ENTITIES DESIGNATED IN R 460.20601 (RULE 901) AND R 460.20602 (RULE 902), at the price listed:

(2) The following office of pipeline safety, research and special programs administration standards are adopted by reference in these rules THIS RULE and are available, FROM THE ENTITIES DESIGNATED IN R 460.20601 (RULE 901) AND R 460.20602 (RULE 902), at a cost as of the time of adoption of ~~these rules~~ THIS RULE of \$11 .00 for a single volume that contains all of the standards:
