**ORDER**

On August 17, 2000, the Commission commenced a rulemaking proceeding to consider  
rescission of the recent revisions to the Consumer Standards and Billing Practices for Electric and  
Gas Residential Service that became effective March 17, 2000.

The Commission has concluded that this rulemaking proceeding should be terminated.

The Commission FINDS that:

and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The rulemaking proceeding commenced on August 17, 2000 should be terminated.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the docket in this proceeding is closed and all further proceedings in this matter are terminated.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
