R 460.20606 of the Michigan Administrative Code is amended as follows:

PART 6. ADOPTION OF STANDARDS

R 460.20606 Office of pipeline safety, research and special programs administration standards; adoption by reference.

Rule 906. (1) The following office of pipeline safety, research and special programs administration standard is adopted by reference in ~~these rules~~ THIS RULE and is available, FROM THE ENTITIES DESIGNATED IN R 460.20601 (RULE 901) AND R 460.20602 (RULE 902), at the price listed:

49 C.F.R. part 40 entitled "Procedures for Transportation Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Programs," (1998 edition), at a cost as of the time of adoption of ~~these rules~~ THIS RULE of \$31.00.

(2) The following office of pipeline safety, research and special programs administration standards are adopted by reference in ~~these rules~~ THIS RULE and are available, FROM THE ENTITIES DESIGNATED IN R 460.20601 (RULE 901) AND R 460.20602 (RULE 902), at a cost as of the time of adoption of ~~these rules~~ THIS RULE of \$11.00 for a single volume that contains all of the standards:
