**OPINION AND ORDER**

On October 8, 2003, Shell Energy Services Company, L.L.C. (Shell), filed an application for a license to operate as an alternative gas supplier (AGS) pursuant to Public Act 634 of 2002 (Act 634), MCL 460.9 *et seq.* By the order dated June 29, 2004, the Commission granted the Shell's application.

On June 8, 2006, Shell requested the voluntary relinquishment of that license, and the Commission Staff recommends approval of this request, finding that there are no customers adversely affected by the rescission.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 2002 PA 634, MCL 460.9 *et seq.*; 1909 PA 300, as amended, MCL 462.2 *et seq.*; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 *et seq.*; 1939 PA 3, as amended,

MCL 460.1 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*

b. Shell's voluntary relinquishment of its AGS license should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Shell Energy Services Company, L.L.C.'s license as an alternative gas supplier in the State of Michigan is hereby rescinded.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
