**ORDER**

On March 23, 2004, Peoples Energy Services Corporation (Peoples) submitted an application, under 2002 PA 634, MCL 460.9 *et seq.*, for a license to operate as an alternative gas supplier (AGS), and in an order issued on September 21, 2004, the Commission approved Peoples' AGS license in the State of Michigan.

On January 25, 2008, Peoples requested the voluntary relinquishment of its AGS license. The Commission Staff recommends approval of this request, noting that Peoples does not serve any gas choice customers in Michigan.

The Commission finds that Peoples' request to relinquish its AGS license should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Peoples Energy Services Corporation's license as an alternative gas supplier in the State of Michigan is rescinded.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
