ORDER

On November 29, 2005, Major Pipeline, L.L.C. (Major), filed an application, pursuant to the provisions of 1929 PA 9, MCL 483.101 *et seq.*, requesting authority to construct and operate the Brucke Pipeline in Grand Traverse, Antrim, and Kalkaska counties. On May 10, 2006, the Commission issued an order approving a settlement agreement and granting Major authority to construct and operate the Brucke pipeline. On August 16, 2006, Major filed an amended application requesting authority to revise the pipeline route because of concerns about the viability and consistency of long-term gas deliveries on the route proposed in Major’s original application. On October 12, 2006, the Commission approved the amended route. On February 29, 2008 and March 10, 2008, Major submitted third and fourth amended applications. On April 29, 2008 and

May 19, 2008, Major requested to withdraw its third and fourth amended applications. Major stated that it will proceed with the construction of the Brucke pipeline as previously approved by the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the third and fourth amended applications filed by Major Pipeline, L.L.C., requesting authority to construct and operate the Brucke pipeline in Grand Traverse, Antrim, and Kalkaska counties are dismissed.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
