**ORDER**

On February 4, 2009, Debra Davis filed a second amended complaint against Consumers Energy Company (Consumers) and The Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison) alleging a billing dispute. On August 4, 2009, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the portion of the complaint against Detroit Edison with prejudice. On August 11, 2009, a hearing on the portion of the complaint against Consumers was held before Administrative Law Judge Barbara A. Stump (ALJ). The complainant failed to appear at the hearing. The ALJ granted Consumers' motion to dismiss the complaint. The Commission finds that the complaint against Detroit Edison should be dismissed with prejudice and the complaint against Consumers should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the portion of the complaint of Debra Davis against Consumers Energy Company is dismissed and the portion of the complaint against The Detroit Edison Company is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
