**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
IN CONJUNCTION WITH A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER**

On November 18, 1998, QuikPro Express, Inc., (QuikPro) filed an application for motor carrier authority in File No. 27998. On December 9, 1998, the Michigan State Police Motor Carrier Division initiated an investigation of QuikPro based on information that QuikPro had provided for-hire transportation of property without a certificate of authority. The investigation revealed haul-for-hire violations. Subsequently, the Commission Staff and QuikPro entered into negotiations and signed a settlement agreement, attached as Exhibit A.

In the settlement agreement, QuikPro admits it operated without authority. It agrees to pay an administrative assessment of \$1,000 (which has been paid) and to comply with all relevant statutes, rules, and orders.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1933 PA 254, as amended, MCL 475.1 et seq.; MSA 22.531 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; MSA 22.13(1) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. QuikPro Express, Inc., engaged in illegal intrastate transportation.
- c. The settlement agreement is reasonable and in the public interest, and should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The settlement agreement, attached as Exhibit A, is approved.
- B. QuikPro Express, Inc., shall cease and desist from violations of all state and federal motor carrier statutes and rules and the Commission's orders.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26; MSA 22.45.
