**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

On July 12, 1999, the Commission Staff filed a formal complaint against Jeffrey Wayne Bond, d/b/a Jeff Bond Towing, alleging the failure to maintain proper insurance.

Subsequently, the parties entered into a settlement agreement, attached as Exhibit A, resolving all issues.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1933 PA 254, as amended, MCL 475.1 et seq.; MSA 22.531 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; MSA 22.13(1) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL

24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The settlement agreement is reasonable and in the public interest, and should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The settlement agreement, attached as Exhibit A, is approved.

B. Jeffrey Wayne Bond, d/b/a Jeff Bond Towing, shall operate in compliance with the Michigan Motor Carrier Act, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, and the rules, regulations, and orders of the Commission.

C. Jeffrey Wayne Bond, d/b/a Jeff Bond Towing, shall fully comply with the terms of the settlement agreement.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26; MSA 22.45.
