OPINION AND ORDER

On September 4, 2001, Susan Cartwright, d/b/a SJV Delivery Service (SJV), filed an application for motor carrier authority. The Commission Staff (Staff) initiated a safety and fitness review, and the application was set for hearing.

Prior to the hearing, the parties entered into a settlement agreement resolving the Staff's concerns. According to the settlement agreement, attached as Exhibit A, SJV admits that it provided unauthorized for-hire intrastate transportation of property in violation of the Michigan Motor Carrier Act. SJV agrees to pay an assessment of \$1,040.00 and to cease and desist from performing illegal and unsafe transportation services.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1933 PA 254, as amended, MCL 475.1 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the

Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The settlement agreement is reasonable and in the public interest, and should be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The settlement agreement, attached as Exhibit A, is approved.

B. Susan Cartwright, d/b/a SJV Delivery Service, shall pay to the State of Michigan an administrative assessment of \$1,040.00.

C. Susan Cartwright, d/b/a SJV Delivery Service, shall cease and desist from violations of state and federal motor carrier statutes, rules, and orders.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
