ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY DISCONTINUANCE

On August 17, 2001, Gerald H. Janush, d/b/a Jerry's Cartage, filed a request for a three-year extension of the temporary discontinuance of his motor carrier authority. A hearing was held on October 23, 2001 before Administrative Law Judge James Karpen (ALJ) at which one witness testified and one exhibit was admitted into evidence. At the conclusion of the hearing, the ALJ issued an oral Proposal for Decision (PFD) recommending that the Commission grant the requested extension of the temporary discontinuance effective October 1, 2001. No one has filed an exception to the PFD.

The Commission finds that the PFD is supported by the record and should be adopted.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1933 PA 254, as amended, MCL 475.1 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. Mr. Janush's request for a three-year extension of the temporary discontinuance of his motor carrier authority should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the August 17, 2001 application for a three-year extension of the temporary discontinuance of his motor carrier authority filed by Gerald H. Janush, d/b/a Jerry's Cartage, is granted effective October 1, 2001.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
