OPINION AND ORDER

On October 29, 2001, Raymond P. Burton, d/b/a Frost Moving & Storage of Lansing, filed an application to extend the temporary discontinuance of his authority to transport household goods. A hearing was held on March 6, 2002 before Administrative Law Judge James N. Rigas (ALJ). At the conclusion of the hearing, the ALJ issued an oral Proposal for Decision (PFD) recommending that the Commission approve an extension of the temporary discontinuance from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2003. The ALJ also set a schedule for the filing of exceptions to the PFD. No one filed exceptions.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1933 PA 254, as amended, MCL 475.1 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The PFD is supported by the record and should be adopted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The Proposal for Decision is adopted.
- B. The temporary discontinuance of motor carrier authority held by Raymond P. Burton, d/b/a Frost Moving & Storage of Lansing, is granted for the period January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2003.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
