- Cloverland Electric Cooperative will acquire 100% of the equity interest owned by Wisconsin Energy Corporation in Edison Sault Electric Company, if the Michigan Public Service Commission approves its request.

**PARTICIPATION:** Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the January 26, 2010 joint application of Wisconsin Energy Corporation (WEC), Edison Sault Electric Company (Edison Sault) and Cloverland Electric Cooperative (Cloverland), which seeks the Commission's approval, pursuant to MCL 460.6q for the sale and purchase respectively, of 100% of the equity interest in Edison Sault Electric Company to Cloverland.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by February 23, 2010. Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his/her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.
