On December 21, 2009, Attorney Gerard F. Brabant filed a formal complaint on behalf of Springbrook Investments, LLC d/b/a Springbrook Inn (Springbrook Inn) and Grant Grover against Universal Gas & Electric Corporation (Universal Gas & Electric) regarding alleged violations of the natural gas customer choice orders and tariffs approved pursuant to Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) jurisdiction under Public Act 634 of 2002. Complainants are seeking cancellation of any contracts or agreements and awarding their costs.

On January 15, 2010, the Commission served a complaint upon Universal Gas & Electric directing a response on or before February 5, 2010.

The complaint may be dismissed if the Complainants fail to attend the hearing without requesting an adjournment pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure R 460.17315 and R 460.17335. The same complaint may not be refiled at a later time unless a compelling reason is provided for not appearing or requesting another hearing.
