MICHIGAN GAS UTILITIES CORPORATION

- Michigan Gas Utilities Corporation plans to use a gas cost recovery factor of up to \$7.0492 per thousand cubic feet (Mcf) for the twelve months ending March 31, 2011, if the Michigan Public Service Commission approves its request.

PARTICIPATION: Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a hearing to consider the December 30, 2009 application of Michigan Gas Utilities Corporation (MGUC), to implement a gas cost recovery (GCR) plan and gas cost recovery factor of up to \$7.0492 per Mcf to compute its natural gas customers' bills for the 12-month period ending March 31, 2011. MGUC also seeks authority to implement the Contingency Factors Matrix for the period April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011.

All documents filed in this case shall be submitted electronically through the Commission's E-Dockets Website at: michigan.gov/mpscedockets. Requirements and instructions for filing can be found in the User Manual on the E-Dockets help page. Documents may also be submitted, in Word or PDF format, as an attachment to an email sent to mpscedockets@michigan.gov. Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by February 9, 2010. (Interested persons may elect to file using the traditional paper format.) The proof of service shall indicate service upon MGUC's attorney, Sherri Wellman, Miller, Canfield, Paddock and Stone, P.L.C., One Michigan Avenue, Suite 900, Lansing, Michigan 48933.

Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.

Requests for adjournment must be made pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure R 460.17315 and R 460.17335. Requests for further information on adjournment should be directed to (517) 241-6060.
