- SEMCO Energy Gas Company plans to use a gas cost recovery factor of \$6.6377 per thousand cubic feet (Mcf) to compute bills for its M.P.S.C. Division natural gas customers for the billing months of April 2010 through March 2011, if the Michigan Public Service Commission approves its request.

The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the December 22, 2009 application of SEMCO Energy Gas Company (SEMCO), to use a gas cost recovery (GCR) factor of \$6.6377 per Mcf to compute bills for its M.P.S.C. Division natural gas customers for the April 2010 through March 2011 billing months. SEMCO also seeks authority to implement a Contingency Factor Matrix.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by February 4, 2010. (Interested persons may elect to file using the traditional paper format.) Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.
