- Presque Isle Electric & Gas Co-op will implement a uniform gas cost recovery plan and factor of \$0.7914 per hundred cubic feet for the months of April 2010 through March 2011, plus additional amounts contingent on future events, if the Michigan Public Service Commission approves its request.

**PARTICIPATION:**            Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the December 30, 2009 application of Presque Isle Electric & Gas Co-op (Presque Isle) for approval of a gas cost recovery (GCR) plan and factor of \$0.7914 per hundred cubic feet (CCF) for the months of April 2010 through March 2011, plus additional amounts contingent on future events. Presque Isle's requested contingent GCR factor ceiling prices would be calculated using a Quarterly Adjustment Process to reflect increases in the price of gas on the New York Mercantile Exchange (NYMEX).

All documents filed in this case shall be submitted electronically through the Commission's E-Dockets Website at: [michigan.gov/mpscedockets](http://michigan.gov/mpscedockets). Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by March 16, 2010. (Interested persons may elect to file using the traditional paper format.) The proof of service shall indicate service upon Presque Isle's attorney, Joseph J. Baumann, Dykema Gossett PLLC, Capitol View, 201 Townsend Street, Suite 900, Lansing, Michigan 48933.

Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.

This letter supercedes my January 15, 2010 letter and Notice of Hearing in Case No. U-16151. Presque Isle Electric & Gas Co-op shall mail, by March 9, 2010, a copy of the enclosed notice of hearing to all cities, incorporated villages, townships and counties in its Michigan natural gas service area and to all intervenors in Cases Numbers U-15775 and U-15776. Proof of service shall be filed by the prehearing conference on March 23, 2010.

Presque Isle Electric & Gas Co-op shall cause the enclosed notice of hearing to be published, by March 9, 2010, in daily newspapers of general circulation in its Michigan natural gas service area or published and mailed to its member-customers in Country Lines. If newspapers of general circulation are used, the publication shall occur in each county in which the cooperative provides natural gas service. Publishing requirements and a copy of the publishing format are enclosed. Affidavits of publication shall be filed by the prehearing conference on March 23, 2010.

Presque Isle Electric & Gas Co-op shall by March 23, 2010, serve upon each person who has petitioned to intervene a copy of the written direct testimony of its proposed witnesses and the proposed exhibits as filed with the Commission. Proof of service shall be filed with the Commission by March 30, 2010.
