- South Romeo Gas Storage Company, L.L.C. will increase the maximum stabilized wellhead pressure of its storage facility, if the Michigan Public Service Commission grants it a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

PARTICIPATION: Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the December 30, 2009 application of South Romeo Gas Storage Company, L.L.C. (SRGS), which seeks approval for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to increase the maximum stabilized wellhead pressure of The Washington 28 Storage Field.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by February 25, 2010. Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.
